Coulport Disarmament Camp 29 July – 12 August 2006 Coulport - Scotland

RNAD Coulport is the storage place for the UK's WMDs, the **Trident nuclear warheads**. Just half a mile away from the base, along the shores of Loch Long, you will find the **Peaton Glen Wood** camp site, a grassy field at the roadside with beautiful mixed woodland beyond it. This is the place to be this summer if you are interested in pouring sugar into the war machine and having **fun** while doing it!

The Coulport Disarmament Camp is organised by **Trident Ploughshares**, a **nonviolent direct action** group hammering their way towards a nuclear weapons free world. You don't have to be a Trident Ploughshares pledger to attend the camp. As long as you are willing to abide by our **nonviolence guidelines** you are **very welcome!**

Practicalities

Since we are camping, you will need to bring your own **tent** and **sleeping stuff**. Please bring a **torch** with you to get you around the site (and maybe elsewhere!) after dark. **Boots** are also advisable – explorations of the Coulport and Faslane bases, with surroundings, involves tramping across rough and soggy ground. **Insect repellent** will also come in handy, the Royal Navy recommends SkinSoSoft, and so do we.

There will be a **communal kitchen**, where main **vegan meals** will be cooked. At other times feel free to make **hot drinks** and **snacks** here. Suggested donation towards food is £3/day. Chopping veg, washing up, fetching water, collecting firewood and so on are all tasks that need doing and help with this is much appreciated. The camp has **compost toilets**. A range of disarmament tools will be available, but feel free to bring your own props and tools if you wish.

Please leave your **dogs at home**. This is an action camp and there are no special arrangements for looking after **small children**. Please look after them constantly since there are many potential “dangers” around. If you are **under 16** please check out the website for details.

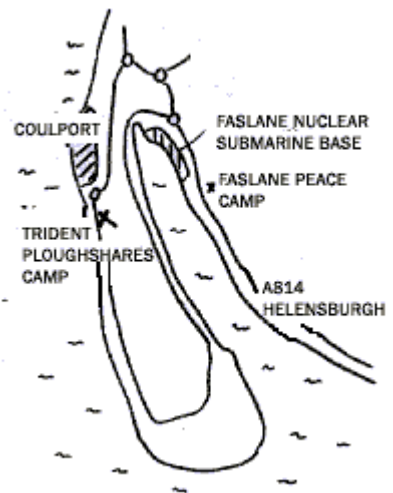
How to get there: There are two trains an hour from Glasgow Queen Street Low Level to Helensburgh Central. The bus to Coulport (which passes the TP camp) leaves from opposite the station every hour (ask to be dropped off at the phone box at Ardpeaton). Or call the camp – there might be lifts.
